

CLEAN SITE. SAFE SITE.

Housekeeping. Most slips, trips and falls start with something left lying around.

~30% of reported non-fatal workplace injuries are slips, trips and falls on the same level (HSE, UK).



1 KEEP WALKWAYS CLEAR
Aisles, stairs and exits stay open at all times. Nothing stored in an escape route, even for a minute.

2 DEAL WITH SPILLS NOW
Clean it, or cone and sign it, and report it. A spill left for someone else is a spill someone falls on.

3 CABLES AND HOSES OFF ROUTES
Run them overhead or along walls, or cover them. Never across a walkway or doorway.

4 STORE IT PROPERLY
Racking and shelving rated for the load, heavy items low, nothing leaning against walls or stacked above head height.

5 WASTE TO THE BIN, DAILY
Offcuts, packaging and rubble cleared as you go. Every shift ends with a tidy area.

6 REPORT DEFECTS
Damaged floors, poor lighting, missing handrails and blocked drains go in the register the day you spot them.

**If you see it, sort it.
If you can't, report it.**
